Now these numbers are not just your average 'attached-to-the -house-by-the-front-door-over-the-mailbox'. Nope, they ranged from freestanding, floating or fastened to a divider or boulder & everything in between.

Gosh how I wish I had thought of this idea! But even tho' I didn't, I can at least have fun enlightening your world! (Plus New Visitors & Local Cabbies will be forever grateful!)

When looking to announce your address to the world - there's a few key things to keep in mind:

- * make sure the background is conducive to seeing the address clearly
- * text should be large enough to easily read (particularly for those of us nearsighted folks!)



* simple to read digits or lettering are ideal



- feast your eyes on the drama created here!

* place them in a logical location where you most expect numbers to be. Avoid putting them on step faces, bottoms of doors, sunk into or painted onto sidewalks or step landings, in plant pots or anyplace that is not near the main entrance or garage. They will be frustrating to visually locate unless they are extremely oversized.





- 'script' house address are very classy looking

- & so aremixes of 'letters'& numbers!



* lit up at night is best - I don't think I need to elaborate there!



- floating 'symbols' like these are not only sharp looking but they are one of the first things that catch your attention.



* use the opportunity to add some personality & street appeal to your front entrance!

PLANT OF THE MONTH

CIMICIFUGA 'Racemosa'

(aka Bugbane or Black Cohosh - yes - THAT black cohosh :)

I was turned on to this incredible perennial by a friend of mine recently. I'd heard about it before (& what woman over 40 hasn't heard of Black Cohosh?;) but wasn't sure if it would survive nicely in Saskatoon. Turns out - it is very hardy!



It might be tricky to find this Spring but well worth your hunt. Reaching heights of 4'- 5' with a spread of about 3'- 4', the burgundy tinged stems as well as underside of the foliage only increases it's appeal when it blooms late summer. It'll take morning sun but is TOTALLY shade tolerant & if that weren't enough - produces incredibly FRAGRANT blossoms. This might just be THE *perfect* plant!
